Operationalization of the Regional Agreement and Commencement of Residence Requirements

August 21, 2026 – The Investment Migration Agency Grenada (IMA Grenada) wishes to advise that, as part of Grenada's obligations arising under the Eastern Caribbean Citizenship by Investment Regulatory Authority Agreement and the related amendments adopted in 2025 and 2026, clarification is being provided regarding the implementation and commencement of the requirements arising thereunder.

Notwithstanding the recent amendment concerning the residence requirement, which is scheduled to commence on August 31, 2026, the implementation of the residence requirement, together with the other obligations and requirements arising under the regional framework, will not take effect until the relevant regional regulator has been operationalized and all participating Member States have formally agreed upon and communicated an effective commencement date.

Accordingly, the commencement of the requirement will be subject to the operationalization of the regional regulator and the formal establishment of an effective commencement date by the participating Member States.

IMA Grenada will issue further guidance once the regional regulator has been operationalized and the participating Member States have formally established the effective commencement date and any applicable implementation arrangements.

All stakeholders are therefore encouraged to await further official communication from IMA Grenada regarding the commencement of the residence requirement and the other related regional requirements.

The Agency appreciates your cooperation and continued adherence to the applicable legislative and regulatory requirements.
